**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-0078**

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARD DESIGN FOR PNP SIGNBOARD**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention, and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards, and medals of honor";

**WHEREAS**, NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019, defined the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment that are germane and fit to the intended use, purpose, and objective of the items to be acquired or procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

**WHEREAS**, the PNP through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) endorsed to the Commission the approved Technical Working Group for the Formulation and Amendment of Standards (TWG-FAS) Resolution No. 2021-12-029 dated December 9, 2021, on the proposed minimum standards for PNP Signboard with attached documentary requirements, for consideration and approval;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed minimum standards for Signboard refer to an information, signage board carrying the name of PNP units/offices to be installed and displayed at the upper middle facade of PNP office building structures;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation of the minimum standards and pertinent documents submitted by the PNP, the Commission finds the same to be in order and to conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), all existing policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the minimum standard design for PNP Signboards, to read as follows:

- a. Design/Construction - A custom-made rectangular shape information public sign made of latest material/technology that is visible and backlighted with braced frame structure
  
- b. Content - Shall bear the following information:
  - a) PNP's/Office's/Unit's Logo;
  - b) The name "National Police Commission" and "Philippine National Police";
  - c) Office/Unit name and address; and
  - d) Office's/Unit's motto.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications of the PNP Signboards which will be the basis for its procurement, and shall ensure that the same comply, conform, and are within the aforementioned minimum standards, and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, the National Building Code and are advantageous to the PNP.

**RESOLVED FURTHERMORE**, that any other existing issuances inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed or rescinded.
