**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-0500**

**CONFIRMING THE LEVEL OF PASSING FOR THE MAY 29, 2022  
 NAPOLCOM SPECIAL QUALIFYING ELIGIBILITY (NSQE) EXAMINATION**

**WHEREAS**, Section 21 of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 8551, otherwise known as the "PNP Reform and Reorganization Act of 1998", amending Section 32 of R.A. No. 6975, provides that the National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examinations for policemen on the basis of standards set by the Commission;

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 (a) (1) of R.A. No. 8551, provides that the Commission shall develop policies and promulgate a police manual prescribing rules and regulations for efficient organization, administration, and operation, including criteria for manpower allocation, distribution and deployment, recruitment, selection, promotion, and retirement of personnel and the conduct of qualifying entrance and promotional examinations for uniformed members;

**WHEREAS**, Paragraph 3, Section 2, Article XI of R.A. No. 11054, entitled "An Act Providing for the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, Repealing for the Purpose Republic Act No. 6734 or An Act Providing for An Organic Act for the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, As Amended by Republic Act No. 9054 or An Act to Strengthen and Expand the Organic Act for the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao", provides:

xxx

*"To facilitate entry into the Philippine National Police of Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF) members from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region, the age, height and educational attainment requirements may be waived by the National Police Commission, subject to existing rules and regulations: Provided, That such shall be availed of within a period of five (5) years from ratification of this Organic Law: Provided, further, That the requirement of educational attainment shall be complied within fifteen (15) years from their entry: Provided, finally, That their ranks and grades shall be subject to existing laws, rules and regulations governing the Philippine National Police. xxx"*

**WHEREAS**, Paragraph 6 of NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2022-0081, provides that:

xxx

*"eligibility, as one of the minimum qualification standards for appointment in the PNP, is not covered by a waiver provision under existing laws, rules and regulations. xxx"*

**WHEREAS**, the Commission, through NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2022-0081, prescribed NAPOLCOM Special Qualifying Eligibility (NSQE) as the appropriate eligibility for temporary appointment to the rank of Patrolman/Patrolwoman in the Philippine National Police (PNP) for members of the MILF and MNLF. Said appropriate eligibility can be acquired through NSQE Examination;

**WHEREAS**, in compliance with the foregoing, the Commission administered the NSQE Examination on May 29, 2022;


**WHEREAS**, in order to determine who passed and failed the said examination, forty percent (40%) correct answers of the total number of test items was prescribed as the level of passing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commission, in the exercise of its constitutional power to administer Entrance and Promotional Examinations, **HAS RESOLVED TO CONFIRM, AS IT HEREBY CONFIRMS**, that the level of passing for the aforementioned examination is forty percent (40%) correct answers of the total number of test items.
